



NOTICE TO ALL RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF ANADARKO

The City of Anadarko has identified a substantial number of properties that are not compliant to city code Title 4 Sections 3A-1 thru 3A-4 and Title 4 Section 3-10. The properties need to be cleaned up, mowed, trees trimmed, debris removed, and in some instances, demolition is necessary.

As a result, the City of Anadarko has scheduled City Wide Clean Up Days April 15th 2019 thru April 19th 2019. The city will be divided into 4 sections as follows:

- Day 1, April 15th, 2018 west of 1st Street and North from Georgia Street
- Day 2, April 16th, 2018 west of 1st Street and South of Alabama Street
- Day 3, April 17th, 2018 all area's East of 1st Street and North of Central Blvd
- Day 4 April 18th, 2019 all area's East of 1st Street and South of Central Blvd.

All debris must be bagged or contained and placed at the curb prior to the date scheduled for your area. City crews will pick up only items at the curb and will pick up in your area only one time. Furniture, refrigerators, freezers, stoves, and bulky items can be placed at the curb or delivered to the site below. **No hazardous items can be set out for disposal.**

If you cannot have your items at the curb on your scheduled day you can take items to our central roll off site during the cleanup dates. You can also take large items and debris to the Alex land fill at no charge if you have a photo ID and a copy of a recent utility bill. Roll Off Hours are Wednesday thru Saturday 9am – 6pm.

- A tire disposal unit will be set up at the Police Department, 201 NE First.
- In addition to the Roll Off location at 507 North Country Club road; Roll offs will be located at the Anadarko Police Department.

Please keep in mind, city crews will complete a onetime only curbside pickup in your neighborhood on the scheduled dates. All properties not cleaned up by the April 21st, 2019 will be subject to code violations pursuant to the city codes referenced above.
